HISTORY OF VAT RATES AND COVERAGE (major changes only)

1 April 1973	VAT introduced. Standard rate 10 per cent. Zero rate covered food, fuel, new housing and alterations, public transport, young children's clothing, books and newspapers.
1 April 1974	Standard rate extended to petrol and snack foods (crisps, sweets and lollies).
29 July 1974	Standard rate cut to 8 per cent.
18 November 1974	New 25 per cent rate on petrol.
1 May 1975	25 per cent higher rate extended to TVs, radios, electric domestic appliances, cameras, jewellery, boats, caravans.
12 April 1976	Higher rate cut to $12\frac{1}{2}$ per cent.
18 June 1979	Standard rate raised to 15 per cent (no higher rate).
1 May 1984	Standard rate extended to hot takeaway food and drink.
1 June 1984	Standard rate extended to alterations to buildings.
1 May 1985	Standard rate extended to newspaper advertising.
