Dear Mrs Thatcher,

It was an honour and a pleasure to be invited to Chequers last weekend. Thank you very much for the excellent hospitality.

Thank you also for listening so carefully to the many views expressed about the Health service. I am a passionate supporter of the service but recognise its failings.

In international terms it delivers health care efficiently and yet it is undeniably inefficient. Again by international comparisons it is cheap and yet the considerably extra sums your government has spent have not

produced the improvements that might have been expected. Overall it provides good health care but I fear that many of our customers are not looked after as they should be. It has low overall administrative costs but is overburdened by administration especially at the QHAs, RHA and at the centre. Many people work very hard but often not as effectively as they might and restrictive practices are apparent in all groups.

The most urgent need, in my view, is to introduce more choice to obtain efficiency by competition. The progressive extension of an 'internal market' within the NHS with controlled expansion of the private sector is an attractive proposition.
